VA secretary steps into election campaign, blasts socialism as bad for Veterans care



[Veterans Affairs Secretary Robert Wilkie](#) warned his department's core services "would be gone" if socialist ideals were to take over America — a swipe at the [Democratic front runner](#) to replace President Donald Trump.

"If socialism became the coin of the realm, that [care for veterans] would be gone," Wilkie said in an interview with the far-right media outlet Breitbart at the annual Conservative Political Action Conference on Friday. "That place that was promised for warriors would disappear."

The event, which had an announced theme of “America vs. Socialism,” featured Republican leaders attacking their political foes as dangerous for the country.

Wilkie attended the event but did not take the stage to give a speech. He told Breitbart that “socialism would wipe (VA) out” if allowed to take over American politics.

VA promises new plan to address needs of growing population of elderly vets

Veterans Affairs officials will release a new strategic plan later this month on the [health care demands](#) of the country’s rapidly aging veterans population, in response to [recent concerns](#) that the department is ill-prepared for the looming issue.

During an appearance before the [House Veterans’ Affairs Committee](#) on Tuesday, Teresa Boyd, assistant deputy under secretary for health at VA, said the comprehensive plan — referenced by other department officials in recent Hill events — will be delivered to lawmakers later in March.

She said current department efforts have “significantly improved the care and well-being of veterans” but also acknowledged the work to be done in coming year.

Today, about half of the 9 million veterans currently enrolled in veterans health care programs are 65 or older. Over the next decade, the number of veterans over 75 in that group is expected to approach 3 million.

The number of veterans aged 85 or older receiving care from VA health services is expected to grow more than five times over the next two decades, as life expectancy continues to improve.
